- What were the main themes in the book?
- How did the author want us to think about these themes? Was there a moral or religious lesson that the author wanted to share with readers?
- What are the most important quotes from the book? Which theme does each quote reflect?
- What is the significance of the title of the story?
- Of all the information presented in the book, what has interested you the most?
- What is one thing you'd like to remember from this book?
- Did this book make you want to explore the topic more?
- Did your opinions on the topic change after reading this book?
- Would you read more books from this author or within the same genre?
- What other books or authors would you recommend on this subject?
- What is your final impression of the book as a whole?

## ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS — FOR BIOGRAPHIES/MEMOIRS

- What did you find most intriguing about the protagonist's story?
- Has this individual generated change or inspired others?
- What was their most admirable quality? What were their weaknesses?

• If you could ask the author/protagonist one question, what would it be?

Has the protagonist given you a new perspective on life or faith?
