- Which character could you relate to or empathize with the most?
- Which characters experienced growth or transformation? What caused these changes?
- What attributes, actions, or choices from the central characters delighted, surprised or frustrated you?
- Did this story have a "Christ Figure"? Which characters might represent goodness and virtue?

THEMES

- What were the main themes of the book?
- How did the author want us to think about these themes? Was there a moral or religious lesson that the author wanted to share with readers?
- What are the most important quotes from the book? Which theme does each quote reflect?
- How does the setting of the story impact the themes?
- Is there any symbolism or metaphor throughout the story? Which themes do they represent?

STORYLINE

- What is the significance of the title of the story?
- Which scene has stuck with you the most?
- What is one thing you'd like to remember from this book?
- What was the most significant point of tension for you in the story?
- Would you read more books from this author or within the same genre?
