

CHARACTERS ON THE FORBIDDEN ISLAND

Heather Longtreader

Heather is a gifted healer and storyteller and is known as *The Scribe of the Cause*. After being stabbed by her Uncle Garten and left for dead on Forbidden Island, Heather must choose between a life with her beloved, Prince Smalls, or self-sacrifice for the good of all Rabbitkind and the dream of the Mended Wood.

Prince Jupiter Smalls

Jupiter Smalls, the rightful heir of Natalia, is a brave, loyal and courageous rabbit.

The Dragon Prince/The Keeper

The Dragon Prince is a dragon whose title is self-claimed; he is a wicked imposter. Posing as 'The Keeper' – a sole Dragon on Forbidden Island whose job is to nurture the dragon eggs, keep conference with the Rabbit Kings of Natalia, and raise the next Keeper – this imposter has killed the rightful Keeper and broken the treaty with rabbit kind, his intent to maliciously kill and rule over Natalia.

CHARACTERS IN FIRST WARREN

Picket Longtreader

Picket's heroic deeds while fighting wolves and birds of prey have earned him the name of "Picket Packslayer". Picket is willing to do whatever it takes to fight for the goodness, truth, and beauty of the Mended Wood; including giving up his life.

Captain Helmer

Helmer is a Captain of Princess Emma's army, a war hero, and a mentor to Picket. He is brave against his foes, and while he seems fearless, he greatly fears those he loves being harmed or killed by the enemy. The protection of his beloved friends and family spurs him on, even though he believes the cause will likely fail.

Princess Emma

Emma is the heir of Natalia since Smalls is still believed to be dead. Emma is a courageous leader, who fiercely and fearlessly leads the rabbits. While a wonderland and selfless leader, her heart desires to heal; she would not have chosen leadership given the choice but would prefer life as a humble doctor.

Prince Kylen (Kyle)

Prince Kylen is the heir of Terralain. He is stubborn and refuses to join forces with Emma and the other Natalia rabbits against Morbin because he believes Picket to be responsible for his father's death.

Jo Shanks

Jo Shanks is an expert Archer and trusted friend of Pickets and Princess Emma. His courageous shot which took down two Prey Lords at once, makes him a hero among Natalia's rabbits.

CHARACTERS IN AKOLAN

The Tunneler

The Tunneler is the title for the rabbit who has the extraordinary job of preparing the way for the "final protocol"; the escape and liberation of the Akolan rabbits. This title is passed from rabbit to rabbit, each with the responsibility of keeping secret the rescue plan. In Embers End, Whittle, Heather and Picket's father, is the tunneler.

Garten Longtreader

Garten is Wilfred's brother, and Heather and Picket's uncle. He is a traitor who betrayed his brothers and King Jupiter which resulted in King Jupiter's death at the claws of Morbin. He is the leader of the 'Longtreaders' of Akolan.

Morbin Blackhawk

Morbin is the king of the Lords of Prey. He is evil and desires complete dominance over the land of Natalia.

STORYLINE

After the dramatic battle for First Warren is won, the Natalia rabbits are preparing for the final battle. This battle will lead to the triumph conclusion and fulfilment of the Mended Wood, or if the rabbits fail, desolation, destruction and death by succumbing to the Prey Lords' wicked rule. These courageous rabbits are surrounded by enemies. At every turn there are wolves, Prey Lords, and traitor rabbits; but as we follow the perspectives of Picket and Jo Shanks, we discover just how much courage these rabbits possess.

Simultaneously, on Forbidden Mountain Heather and Smalls have encountered the Dragons. With so many questions, and an uncertainty over whether or not these vicious-looking creatures can be trusted, Heather and Smalls must choose between saving Rabbitkind or their love and a future together.
